



About our special awards.....

Year Community Awards

These awards are given to students who have contributed to the community, either within or outside of school. They are nominated by teachers and/or Head of Year.

Helen Smith Memorial Award for Mathematics

Helen Smith taught in the Mathematics Faculty from 2001 until she passed away in 2005. During this time she helped to shape the way Mathematics is taught at Highlands and was of particular support to students with special needs, whether these be of the most or least able mathematicians. This award is dedicated to her memory and aims to recognise a student who has made particularly good progress through their commitment to learning.

The Professional Role Players Award for Excellence in Performing Arts

This is awarded to a person or persons who have displayed the ability to work well with others and bring out the best in all their performances throughout the year. The Professional Role Player's Award is about more than being a great actor. We look for someone who has, not only, proven themselves on stage, but is also dedicated and conscientious throughout the rehearsal period. The recipient will have developed their skills across drama, dance and music and be a truly 'professional' role player.

Stanley Watson Memorial Award for Community Service

Stanley Watson was an LEA member of the Governing Body, from the opening of the School in 2000 and made a very valuable contribution to the development of Highlands. Stanley Watson died in May 2004 and his family donated an award in his memory for Community Service, an area close to Stanley's heart.

Governor's Award for Outstanding Academic Achievement

This award is presented by Highlands School Governing Body and is awarded to the student who has achieved the highest combined academic achievement across the three core subjects; English, Maths and Science.
