Progression Evening Tuesday 23rd April 6pm

Parents and Carers are invited to school on Tuesday 23rd April at 6pm for an **information evening** where we will be issuing Interim reports we will also cover effective strategies for revision. We expect that you will leave this meeting with examples of good practice and a list of resources that, once put into action, will support your child's progress. Following this you will be given information on the university application process. I would encourage at least one representative from each family to attend this important event so that the key messages and application deadlines can be reinforced at home.

It is now time for all students to begin considering their options after the Sixth Form and for the majority of our students this means preparing to apply to university, for employment or for a place as an apprentice. To launch this important stage all students will attend a one-day conference held at the school on Monday 1st July, focused on their options after the sixth form.

This programme for the day includes:

- The option available at age 18.
- An introduction to the application process for employment, apprenticeships or university.
- A workshop focused on writing an effective CV or Personal Statement, led by university admission tutors.
- Computer software to help students match their interests and aspirations to careers and study courses.
- Exploring the factors that influence the choice of university and course.

Some students will be required to take resit examinations in June and we will explain our timetable for immediate support classes.
