IMPORTANT DATES

Friday 10 May:

- Regular timetable day, best smart dress (non-uniform) & shirt signing (bring your school shirt),
- At the end of the day an assembly followed by a BBQ

PHASE 1

From Monday 13 May to half-term break
(Weeks 1 & 2)

- Each day – AM registration and normal morning lessons or exam
- Home Study from either period 4 or 5 onwards (unless you have an exam or camp), you may take lunch in the dining hall before you leave.
- Attend all STUDY CAMPS (for all students)
- Details given below for each day
- If you have been withdrawn from a subject then go to your normal lesson during that exam time

PHASE 2

From Monday 3 June onwards
(Weeks 3 to 5)

- Attend all STUDY CAMPS (for all students) as shown in the timetable below
- Home Study for the remainder of the time
- Your teachers will be available in your normal lesson times for help and advice

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- For some CAMPS subject groupings / rooms might change – check with your teachers
 - Full school uniform must be worn correctly at all times and all normal school rules must be followed

MORNING EXAMS:

Before: Arrive at 8.30am and wait in the canteen until called in

After: Follow the timetable given below

AFTERNOON EXAM:

Before: Arrive at 1.00pm and wait in the canteen until called in

After: Home study or Study Camp

BE PREPARED:

- Always CHECK your OWN EXAM TIMETABLE - if unsure, see the exams officer
- CHECK the TIER of entry – if unsure, see your teacher/ the exam officer before the exam
- Check your SEAT NUMBER with the seating plan on display - if your seat is not in the school hall, wait outside the examination room
- EQUIPMENT: Remember you need a clear pencil case with all equipment in. Recommended at least 2 black pens, 2 pencils, ruler, eraser, sharpener and if needed a calculator, protractor and compass.
- WATER - You may bring a small clear unopened bottle of water with the label removed.
- MOBILE PHONE - Remember to switch off and place in your bag. It must not be in your pocket.
- WATCHES must be placed on the desk – not worn.
- Smart watches are not allowed
