In after school clubs and on Open Evening students helped us to create poppies in different materials. The Resistant Materials area made poppies from recycled plastic bottle and put up a display in the Foyer.



In the Textiles club they made individual fabric poppies which were sold to students and staff and raised £77.

In the Food club they made cupcakes with poppy decorations and held a cake sale in school on Friday 9th November and raised £75.50



On Open Evening Mrs Jones made wooden poppies with the fantastic help of students (KS3 and KS4). They made a colossal 297 poppies. These were sold in school and raised £185.
